What is femicide?

Femicide is the most extreme form of gender-based violence: the killing of a woman because of her gender.

What is the 16 Days Campaign?

The 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence is a global campaign that promotes awareness, advocacy, and solutions to combat violence against women and girls.

From November 25 - December 10, this year's campaign focuses on femicide.

Nearly 7,000 dowry deaths occurred in India in 2020.

In **Spain,** femicides have more than doubled compared to pre-pandemic levels.

May 2020: 1 femicide **every week.**May 2021: 1 femicide **every 3 days.**



400 - 500 honor killings
take place each year in Iran.

The perpetrators are almost always male relatives.
